

COVID-19 Precautions at all Locations

Your child's health and safety is our #1 priority

SYMPTOM SCREENING AND TEMPERATURE CHECKS

- Twice daily for staff
- Daily for children



FACIAL COVERINGS REQUIRED

- Masks required for children 6+ and all adults.

ENHANCED SAFETY AT MEALS

- Meals no longer served family-style and teachers serve meals in the classroom to minimize potential contamination.



REDUCED EXPOSURE EFFORTS

- Children play and learn in the same, small classroom groups with the same teachers.
- Only staff who are fully vaccinated are permitted to work in multiple classrooms or float between classrooms.
- No one is permitted in the classroom other than teachers and children. Parents drop off and pick up their children at the classroom door.
- Classrooms with exposures are immediately closed in accordance with health department guidelines.

INCREASED SANITATION

Above and beyond our already stringent cleaning policies and includes:

- Hourly sanitation of public areas
- Daily sanitation of all toys in every classroom
- Removal of all toys that aren't easily sanitized
- Increased handwashing with children



DISTANCE LEARNING SUPPORT

If our partner schools and classrooms close due to exposure, we provide distance learning support for enrolled children in our school age classrooms in partnership with your child's school teachers.

WHAT HASN'T CHANGED

We follow all Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment requirements, as directed by El Paso County Public Health, to ensure our centers remain a safe and healthy place for your child.
